## Mosquito Habitat Checklist

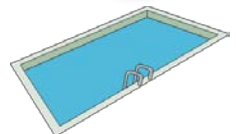
**Water + 7 days = Mosquitoes**

Use this checklist to help find and eliminate places where mosquitoes may breed.

Any container that holds water can be a home for mosquito larvae.

After 7 days, larvae can emerge as adult mosquitoes.

- Garbage cans
- Buckets
- Bird baths
- Tarps
- Planting pots
- Watering cans
- Ornamental ponds
- Gutters
- Toys left outside in yard
- Under decks and porches
- Pools and pool covers
- Boats
- Tires
