

ABOUT THE NEW JERSEY ORGANIZING PROJECT

NJOP is a grassroots organization made up of people like you. We are known for standing up and speaking out for Sandy families. We know how to unify and fight for what is right for our communities. There are still fights we have to take on this year on Sandy Recovery including CLAWBACKS and our push to get the Governor to sign the bill we worked to create that will protect Sandy families struggling to avoid foreclosure. But in 2017 we are launching two new efforts and expanding our work to stand up for all our communities as well as Sandy Survivors.

MOVING FORWARD

2017 is a big year for us. We've elected a new president, and we will elect a new governor. So, in addition to our continued fight for Sandy Recovery we have expanded our focus.

ECONOMIC SECURITY AND DIGNITY FOR ALL: Standing up against cuts to healthcare, medicare and medicaid.

SHORE KEEPER CAMPAIGN: We need to make sure NJ is ready for future storms and has a plan for sea level rise.

WE GET RESULTS

Together, we won the creation of the Rental Assistance Program, and then led a coalition of communities and elected officials to extend rental assistance for families still out of their homes. That resulted in an additional investment of approximately \$15 million in our families and communities, and a lifeline to help many hold on until they are home. We worked with Senate President Sweeney to pass the Efficiency and Transparency in Sandy Recovery Spending Act. And we are still pushing our Governor to sign the bill that is on his desk that would protect Sandy families who are struggling to avoid foreclosure.
